Q: *What do I need to bring?* A: Just yourself!

Q: *Who can attend language class?* A: All those from the communities of: Aquinnah, Assonet, Mashpee, Chapaquiddick and their household family members. Bring the whole family!

Q: *What is immersion style learning?* A: We learn by listening, watching, then doing and saying. We play language games and practice saying what things are, what they look like, and what we are doing. We ask each other questions in the language and answer one another. NO WORKBOOKS and NO WRITTEN HOMEWORK.

Q: *Is there a tuition cost for class?* A: No but we are each required to donate 10 hours of volunteer time to the language project over the next 12 months.
