How did the Wampanoag come to Noepe (Martha's Vineyard)?

Learn about Moshup, our legendary ancestor and the creation stories that have been passed down since the beginning of time. This is a beautiful performance that celebrates Wampanoag oral traditions. The Pageant is staged in a natural amphitheater, overlooking a traditional Wampanoag village setting. Pageant performers weave through the crowd, lit by torches and dressed in full Wampanoag regalia. Traditional singing and dancing styles are only part of the allure.
