

# Let's Go Fly a Kite!



## MATERIALS

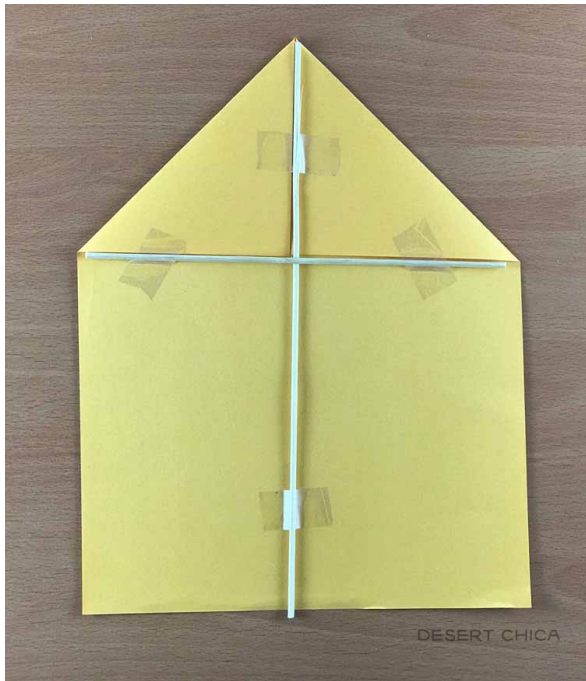

CONSTRUCTION PAPER  
SKEWERS  
STRING

RIBBONS/STREAMERS  
SCOTCH TAPE  
SCISSORS

# INSTRUCTIONS

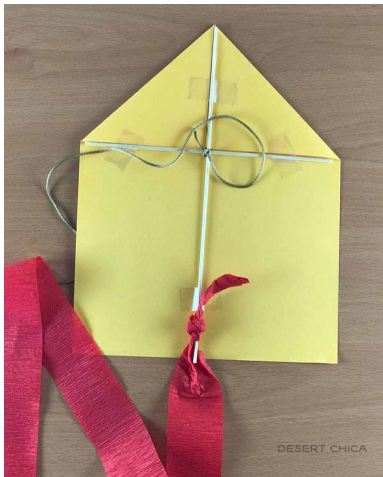

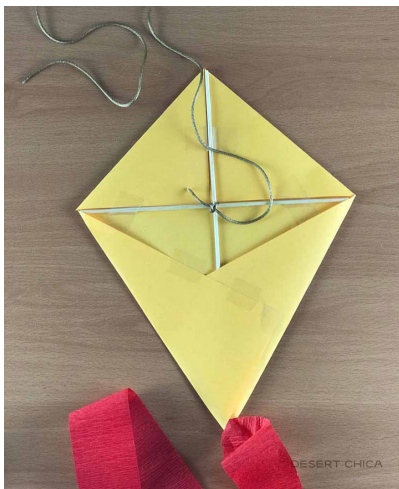
Begin by placing your paper vertically in front of you. Fold the top corners of the paper, similar to a basic paper airplane design. They should meet together in the middle.

*\*Adult will need to trim the second skewer carefully down to size (about 8 inches)*

Then place the skewer down the middle of the paper and tape it in place. Place a trimmed skewer perpendicular across the top of the other skewer. It should sit just below the paper you folded down. Tape it down as well.



Now tie your string where the skewers meet in the middle. Carefully tie the paper streamer or ribbon to the end of the vertical skewer to create the kite tail.



Then fold (and tape) the bottom corners of the paper inward to finish the kite design as pictured here.
